Grand Opening of WER Joell Tennis Stadium

The WER Joell Tennis Stadium hosted a Pickleball Extravaganza to celebrate the official opening of the brand-new courts at the site on Saturday, June 3, 2023. The Extravaganza included a ribbon-cutting ceremony by Owen Darrell, the sports minister, as well as demonstration of pickleball techniques by elite players, open-play events, and those in attendance being given an opportunity to try their hand at the sport. To help meet the demand of the rapid growth of the sport in recent years on island, the Department of Youth, Sport and Recreation, in collaboration with the Pickleball Association of Bermuda, oversaw the conversion of existing tennis courts, designed to provide a state-of-the-art facility for players of all skill levels and ages to enjoy.

Changing the Rules of the Game

There were some rule changes for the game earlier this year! Here is a summary of some changes:

- The serve shall be made with only one hand releasing the ball. While some natural rotation of the ball is expected during any release of the ball from the hand, the server shall not impart manipulation or spin on the ball with any part of the body immediately prior to the serve.
- Players shall avoid wearing clothing that closely matches the ball colour
- If the wrong score is called, the referee or any player may stop play before the return of serve to correct the score.
- In officiated matches, the referee may call for a replay if the referee is not certain that one or more of the requirements of the serve
